

GUIDELINES FOR DOG OWNERS

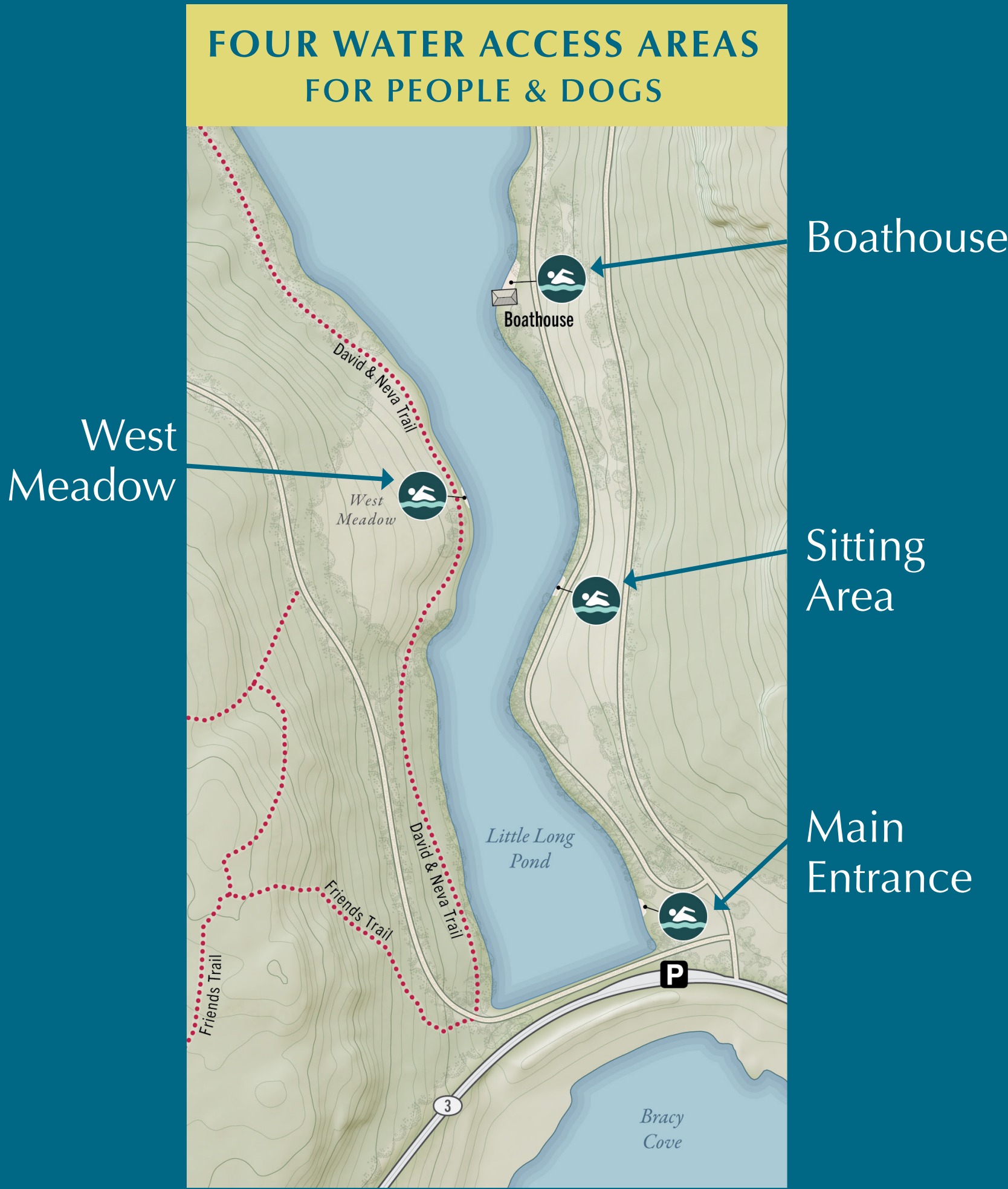


The lands and trails are managed as a nature preserve.

Off-leash dog access is a privilege.

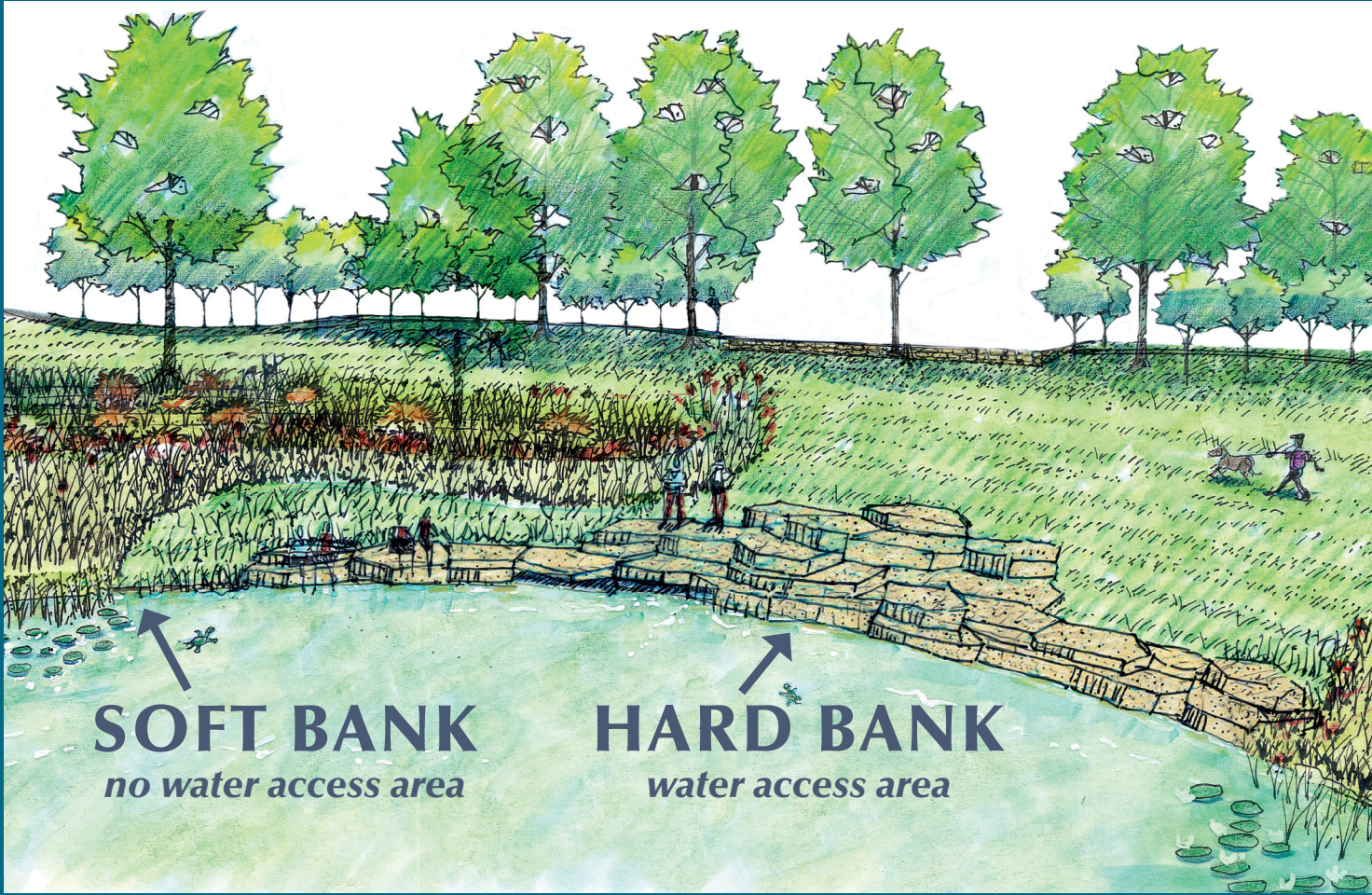
- Allow dogs off-leash only if they are under voice or visual control.
- Keep dogs in sight at all times.
- Allow dogs to swim only in the four designated water access areas.
- Pick up dog waste and dispose in proper receptacles.
- Be considerate of others using the lands who do not want to interact with dogs.
- Keep dogs clear of horses and horse-drawn carriages to keep horses, dogs and humans safe.

The banks of the pond are eroding. Please allow dogs in the pond only at the four water access areas. These areas are reinforced with stone to handle impact.



SOFT BANK
off limits

- + Dogs cause bank erosion
- + Erosion is bad for water quality



HARD BANK
water access area

- + Perfect for dogs
- + Will not lead to erosion
