1. Thread waisted wasp

(Eremnophila spp.)
Pollinates while sipping nectar from flowers.

2. Joe-pye weed

(Eutrochium maculatum)
A pollinator magnet. Grows behind fence at south end of Little Long Pond.

3. **Boneset**

(Eupatorium perfoliatum)
A pollinator magnet. Grows behind fence at south end of Little Long Pond.

4. Wavy-lined emerald moth

(Synchlora aerata)
Its caterpillars feed on boneset.

5. Virgin's bower

(Clematis virginiana)
Grows on fence at south end of Little Long Pond.

6. Early goldenrod

(Solidago juncea)
Very abundant at meadow above boathouse.

7. Bumblebee

(Bombus sp.)
Goldenrod feed many species of bumblebee.
